



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Akebia Therapeutics Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Akebia Therapeutics Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 132% points. The greatest weakness of Akebia Therapeutics Inc. is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 74% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -179%, being 238% points above the market average of -417%.
