



The relative strengths and weaknesses of MyoKardia Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of MyoKardia Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 164% points. The greatest weakness of MyoKardia Inc. is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 59% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 83%, being 499% points above the market average of -417%.
