



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Endo International plc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Endo International plc compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 274% points. The greatest weakness of Endo International plc is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 115% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -8.5%, being 408% points above the market average of -417%.
