



The relative strengths and weaknesses of MyoKardia Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of MyoKardia Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 151% points. The greatest weakness of MyoKardia Inc. is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 53% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 49%, being 326% points above the market average of -278%.
