



The relative strengths and weaknesses of PFIZER INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of PFIZER INC compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 243% points. The greatest weakness of PFIZER INC is the variable Liabilities, Non-Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 37% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 87%, being 419% points above the market average of -331%.
