



The relative strengths and weaknesses of NEKTAR THERAPEUTICS are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of NEKTAR THERAPEUTICS compared to the market average is the variable Assets, Current, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 77% points. The greatest weakness of NEKTAR THERAPEUTICS is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -18%, being 285% points above the market average of -303%.
