



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Pfenex Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Pfenex Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 423% points. The greatest weakness of Pfenex Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 11% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 172%, being 475% points above the market average of -303%.
