



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Minerva Neurosciences Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Minerva Neurosciences Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 125% points. The greatest weakness of Minerva Neurosciences Inc. is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 203% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -413%, being 110% points below the market average of -303%.
