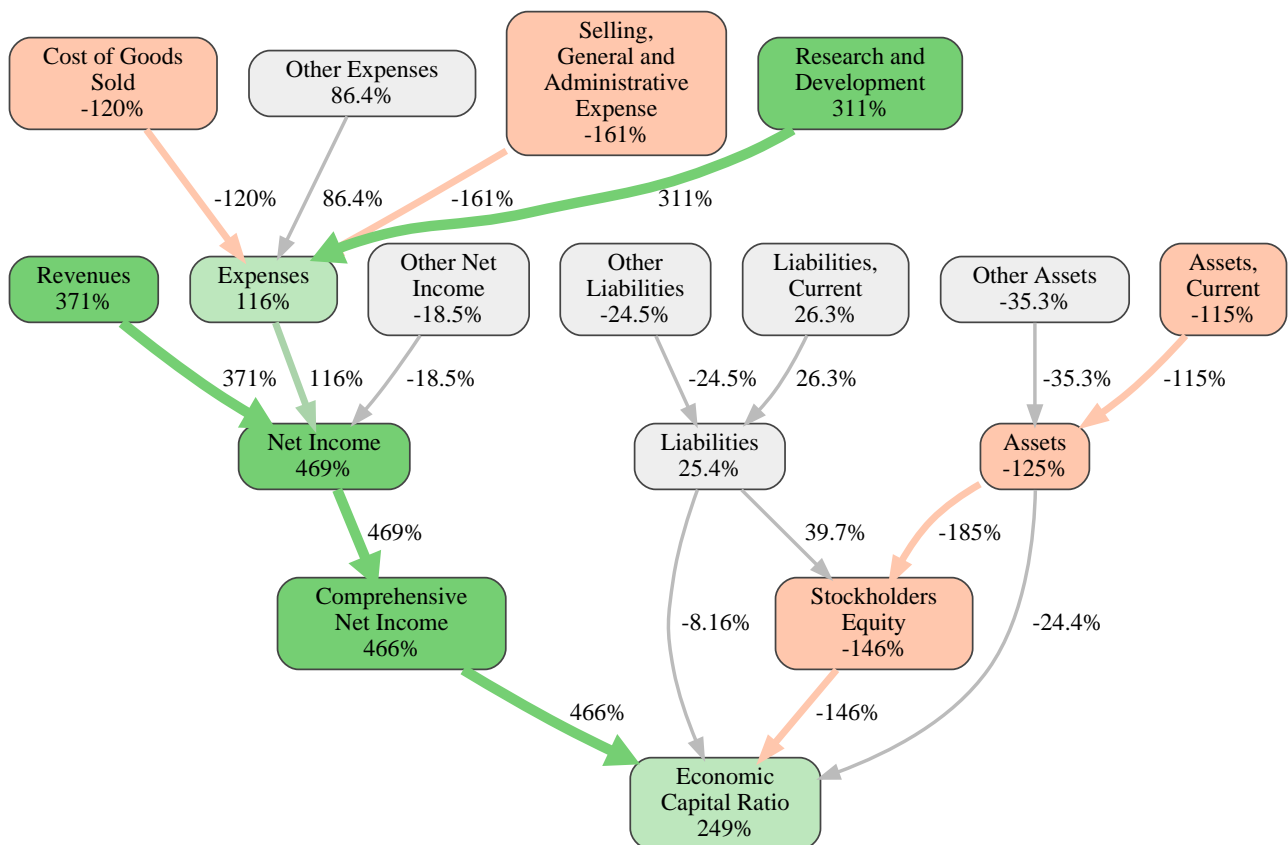

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Organogenesis Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Organogenesis Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 469% points. The greatest weakness of Organogenesis Holdings Inc. is the variable Selling, General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 161% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -53%, being 249% points above the market average of -303%.
