



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Amphastar Pharmaceuticals Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Amphastar Pharmaceuticals Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 351% points. The greatest weakness of Amphastar Pharmaceuticals Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 181% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 123%, being 478% points above the market average of -355%.
