



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Xenon Pharmaceuticals Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Xenon Pharmaceuticals Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 115% points. The greatest weakness of Xenon Pharmaceuticals Inc. is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 66% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 69%, being 424% points above the market average of -355%.
