



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Global Blood Therapeutics Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Global Blood Therapeutics Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points. The greatest weakness of Global Blood Therapeutics Inc. is the variable Selling, General and Administrative Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 56% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -106%, being 248% points above the market average of -355%.
