



The relative strengths and weaknesses of DURECT CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of DURECT CORP compared to the market average is the variable Other Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points. The greatest weakness of DURECT CORP is the variable Research and Development, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 83% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is -112%, being 164% points above the market average of -276%.
