



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Rebus Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Rebus Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 654% points. The greatest weakness of Rebus Holdings Inc. is the variable Liabilities, Current, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 851% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 168%, being 445% points above the market average of -276%.
