



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Schrodinger Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Schrodinger Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 126% points. The greatest weakness of Schrodinger Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 49% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 42%, being 319% points above the market average of -276%.
