



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Organogenesis Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Organogenesis Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 617% points. The greatest weakness of Organogenesis Holdings Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 114% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 202%, being 479% points above the market average of -276%.
