



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Thorne Healthtech Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Thorne Healthtech Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 604% points. The greatest weakness of Thorne Healthtech Inc. is the variable Cost of Goods Sold, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 273% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 136%, being 412% points above the market average of -276%.
