



The relative strengths and weaknesses of NEOPHOTONICS CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of NEOPHOTONICS CORP compared to the market average is the variable Selling, General and Administrative Expense, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points. The greatest weakness of NEOPHOTONICS CORP is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 67% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 5.0%, being 42% points below the market average of 47%.
