



The relative strengths and weaknesses of INTEL CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of INTEL CORP compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 175% points. The greatest weakness of INTEL CORP is the variable Property, Plant and Equipment, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 265%, being 274% points above the market average of -8.7%.
