
**STATE BANKS 2019** 













The relative strengths and weaknesses of BOSTON PRIVATE FINANCIAL HOLDINGS INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of BOSTON PRIVATE FINANCIAL HOLDINGS INC compared to the market average is the variable Liabilities and Borrowings, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points. The greatest weakness of BOSTON PRIVATE FINANCIAL HOLDINGS INC is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 3.7%, being 3.2% points below the market average of 6.9%.
