



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Veritex Holdings Inc. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Veritex Holdings Inc. compared to the market average is the variable Loans and Leases Receivable, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 8.7% points. The greatest weakness of Veritex Holdings Inc. is the variable Cash Deposits and Cash Equivalents, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 2.9% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 8.8%, being 2.3% points above the market average of 6.5%.
