



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Lazard Group LLC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Lazard Group LLC compared to the market average is the variable Operating Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points. The greatest weakness of Lazard Group LLC is the variable Labor Expense, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 19% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 86%, being 4.8% points below the market average of 91%.
