



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Walker Dunlop Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Walker Dunlop Inc compared to the market average is the variable Revenue from Contract with Customer, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points. The greatest weakness of Walker Dunlop Inc is the variable Loans Payable, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 33% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 95%, being 3.1% points above the market average of 92%.
