



The relative strengths and weaknesses of KKR Co Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of KKR Co Inc compared to the market average is the variable Investments, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points. The greatest weakness of KKR Co Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 98%, being 7.7% points above the market average of 90%.
