



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Coinbase Global Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Coinbase Global Inc compared to the market average is the variable Cash and Current Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 11% points. The greatest weakness of Coinbase Global Inc is the variable Operating and Employee Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 64% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 65%, being 24% points below the market average of 90%.
