









The relative strengths and weaknesses of Campbell S Co are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Campbell S Co compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points. The greatest weakness of Campbell S Co is the variable Liabilities, Long Term, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 19% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 142%, being 0.13% points above the market average of 142%.
