



The relative strengths and weaknesses of B G Foods Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of B G Foods Inc compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 16% points. The greatest weakness of B G Foods Inc is the variable Liabilities, Long Term, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 145%, being 17% points below the market average of 162%.
