



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Homefed CORP are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Homefed CORP compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 34% points. The greatest weakness of Homefed CORP is the variable Liabilities, Long-term, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 17% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 88%, being 27% points above the market average of 61%.
