



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Rafael Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Rafael Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 47% points. The greatest weakness of Rafael Holdings Inc is the variable Comprehensive Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 13% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 107%, being 28% points above the market average of 79%.
