



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Ellington Financial Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Ellington Financial Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points. The greatest weakness of Ellington Financial Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 41% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 49%, being 24% points below the market average of 73%.
