



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Retail Value Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Retail Value Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points. The greatest weakness of Retail Value Inc is the variable Real Estate Investment Property, at Cost, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 21% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 49%, being 24% points below the market average of 73%.
