



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Virtu ITG Holdings LLC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Virtu ITG Holdings LLC compared to the market average is the variable Receivables, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 36% points. The greatest weakness of Virtu ITG Holdings LLC is the variable Payables, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 66% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 82%, being 26% points below the market average of 108%.
