



The relative strengths and weaknesses of KBW INC. are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of KBW INC. compared to the market average is the variable Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 38% points. The greatest weakness of KBW INC. is the variable Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 38% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 120%, being 12% points above the market average of 108%.
