

## Ceres Classic L P Rank 73 of 120

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Ceres Classic L P are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Ceres Classic L P compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points. The greatest weakness of Ceres Classic L P is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 34% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 134%, being 0.66% points below the market average of 134%.
