



The relative strengths and weaknesses of NYSE Euronext are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of NYSE Euronext compared to the market average is the variable Goodwill And Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 60% points. The greatest weakness of NYSE Euronext is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 58% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 104%, being 30% points below the market average of 134%.
