

## Merriman Holdings Inc Rank 107 of 108

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Merriman Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Merriman Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 32% points. The greatest weakness of Merriman Holdings Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 204% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 33%, being 104% points below the market average of 136%.
