



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Stonex Group Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Stonex Group Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 59% points. The greatest weakness of Stonex Group Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 1,684% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 59%, being 77% points below the market average of 136%.
