



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Nasdaq INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Nasdaq INC compared to the market average is the variable Goodwill And Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 55% points. The greatest weakness of Nasdaq INC is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 51% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 101%, being 36% points below the market average of 136%.
