



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Invesco DB Energy Fund are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Invesco DB Energy Fund compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 32% points. The greatest weakness of Invesco DB Energy Fund is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 15% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 161%, being 25% points above the market average of 136%.
