



The relative strengths and weaknesses of GAIN Capital Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of GAIN Capital Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Other Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 23% points. The greatest weakness of GAIN Capital Holdings Inc is the variable Payables, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 75% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 71%, being 66% points below the market average of 136%.
