



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Ceres Abingdon L P are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Ceres Abingdon L P compared to the market average is the variable Stockholders Equity, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 39% points. The greatest weakness of Ceres Abingdon L P is the variable Revenues, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 9.7% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 202%, being 59% points above the market average of 143%.
