

The relative strengths and weaknesses of Capital Financial Holdings Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Capital Financial Holdings Inc compared to the market average is the variable Brokerage and Advisory Commissions, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 106% points. The greatest weakness of Capital Financial Holdings Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 593% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 106%, being 29% points below the market average of 135%.
