



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Raymond James Financial INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Raymond James Financial INC compared to the market average is the variable Receivables, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 27% points. The greatest weakness of Raymond James Financial INC is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 72% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 67%, being 81% points below the market average of 147%.
