



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Cowen INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Cowen INC compared to the market average is the variable Receivables, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 14% points. The greatest weakness of Cowen INC is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 74% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 65%, being 84% points below the market average of 149%.
