



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Balance Labs Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Balance Labs Inc compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 22% points. The greatest weakness of Balance Labs Inc is the variable Stockholders Equity, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 30% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 81%, being 67% points below the market average of 148%.
