



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Caesars Holdings INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Caesars Holdings INC compared to the market average is the variable Intangible Assets, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 7.4% points. The greatest weakness of Caesars Holdings INC is the variable Net Income, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 11% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 30%, being 44% points below the market average of 75%.
