



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Stoneridge INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Stoneridge INC compared to the market average is the variable Net Income, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 33% points. The greatest weakness of Stoneridge INC is the variable Other Assets, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 29% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 98%, being 4.3% points below the market average of 102%.
