

Tenneco INC Rank 40 of 56





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The relative strengths and weaknesses of Tenneco INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Tenneco INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 19% points. The greatest weakness of Tenneco INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 40% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 81%, being 29% points below the market average of 110%.
