



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Tesla Inc are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Tesla Inc compared to the market average is the variable Expenses, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 13% points. The greatest weakness of Tesla Inc is the variable Other Liabilities, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 46% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 77%, being 30% points below the market average of 106%.
