



The relative strengths and weaknesses of Stoneridge INC are analyzed with respect to the market average, including all of its competitors. We analyzed all variables having an effect on the Economic Capital Ratio.

The greatest strength of Stoneridge INC compared to the market average is the variable Other Revenues, increasing the Economic Capital Ratio by 31% points. The greatest weakness of Stoneridge INC is the variable Other Expenses, reducing the Economic Capital Ratio by 20% points.

The company's Economic Capital Ratio, given in the ranking table, is 95%, being 10% points below the market average of 105%.
